Thriving Schools Integrated Assessment (TSIA)

TSIA helps identify opportunities to improve policies and practices that promote student achievement and support the well-being of kids, teachers, and staff. The assessment covers the following topics:

- Advancing core policies and practices
- Increasing family and community engagement
- Improving nutrition and food access
- Enriching health education
- Implementing local school wellness policy
- Bolstering physical education and activity
- Strengthening social and emotional health
- Cultivating staff well-being
- Promoting tobacco-free schools
- Supporting school health services
- Reducing chronic absenteeism
- Addressing school discipline
- Fostering positive school climate and culture

Resilience in School Environments (RISE) Index

The RISE Index consists of 40 questions over 5 broad areas. It's one part of the overall RISE initiative, which provides teachers and school staff with a range of skills and resources to support student mental health and to better tend to their own emotional needs, especially during times of uncertainty and increased stress. Through engagement with RISE, schools, teachers, and staff can learn how to better manage emotions, recognize strengths and weaknesses, and rise above adversity.
